



## Talking Points for Inviting Guests to the FCA Victory Dinner

### 1. Warm Greeting:

- Start by saying, “Hi [Name], I hope you’re doing well!” or something casual to set a friendly tone.

### 2. Purpose of the Call:

- “I’m calling because I’m hosting a table at the **Greater Spotsylvania Area FCA Victory Dinner on November 2, 2024**. I am specifically helping (Mike Jennings or Becky Weber) to come on the Battlefield FCA staff full time, and I’d love for you and [spouse/friend] to join us!”

### 3. About the Event:

- “It’s going to be a wonderful evening where we’ll hear powerful testimonies from student-athletes whose lives have been transformed by FCA, enjoy a delicious dinner, and learn more about the exciting work FCA is doing in our community.”

### 4. Who FCA Serves:

- “FCA is working with middle and high schools, college campuses, and sports ministries like girls’ lacrosse and the All Abilities program for individuals with special needs. We’re expanding our reach and helping young athletes grow both in their sport and in their faith.”

### 5. No Cost, but Fundraising Event:

- “There’s no cost to attend the dinner, but since this is a fundraising event, there will be an opportunity to invest in FCA and help support the ministry financially if you feel led.”

### 6. Table Details:

- “My table seats 6, and I’m hoping to fill it with people who would enjoy learning more about FCA and might be interested in supporting the work we’re doing.”

### 7. RSVP and Registration:



- “You can easily register online, and when you do, just make sure to select me as your Table Host so we can sit together.”

#### 8. Encouragement to Attend:

- “I really believe this is going to be an inspiring evening. It’s a great way to hear what God is doing through FCA and be part of something that’s making a difference in our local schools and community.”

#### 9. Answer Questions:

- Be ready to answer questions like:
  - What is FCA? (Fellowship of Christian Athletes, integrating faith and sports)
  - Who will be speaking? (Mike Jennings and Becky Weber, who will be leading FCA efforts locally) As well as our guest speaker State Director George Morris.
  - Can I bring someone with me? (Yes! Feel free to invite others.)

#### 10. Thank Them for Their Consideration:

- “Thank you so much for considering this! I’d love to have you at my table, and I think you’ll be blessed by what you hear that night.” Do you believe you can attend with your (husband, spouse other)?

#### 11. Wrap-Up:

- “I’ll send you the link to register, and I’m really looking forward to spending the evening with you on November 2nd!” **One thing**, as a reminder, when you register it will ask you to select your table host, you will see my name in the list, please select as you register.
